Update on Haiti

"Reports just arriving from Bishop Desvariste in Haiti indicate that in our southern Haitian Conference we have lost three church roofs and four school building roofs. We also have lost at least three smaller church buildings around St. Marc, and some houses destroyed at Gonaives. Folks who have lost housing are gathering in shelters and hoping the church will help." No word on injuries or casualties at this time.

October 7th, FMC Canada authorized \$5,000 from our Bishop's Relief Fund to be distributed in Haiti. Bishop Keith has been in touch with Bishop Desvariste directly, and traveled to Haiti on Wednesday. The Haitian Conference is thankful for the prayer and financial support of the FMCiC.

List of Items Not to Include

NO CANDY OR FOOD



Applicable to Canadian shoeboxes only

- Bubbles
- Camouflage items
- Chap Stick & Lipstick
- Deck of Cards (Poker style with hearts, clubs etc.)
- Dice
- Food—including dry beans, grains, rice, soft candy, gum
- Glow Sticks
- Knives
- Laser Pointers
- Liquids (shampoo, conditioner, body wash, bubble bath)
- Make-up
- Medicines
- Mirrors (not encased in a plastic compact)
- Perfume Sticks
- Seashells
- Seeds
- Skull & Crossbones
- Vitamins
- War-related items (guns, camouflage items)

Five Things To Remember

1. No food items or candy
2. No used or dirty items
3. No liquids or items that leak, melt or freeze
4. No breakable items
5. No items that scare or harm a child



Good to pack:

- School supplies, pencils, paper/ notebooks, pens, coloured pencils
- Clothing/ underwear/socks, hats, mitts, shoes
- Hygiene items/ bars of soap/ toothbrushes/ deodorant (non-liquid), pads/ tampons, razors, facecloth/towel, comb/brush, hair accessories
- Toys, puzzles, Lego, books, children's bibles, soccer ball and pump, dolls, stickers, colouring books
- Sewing kits, (older girls) windup flashlights, small tool kits (older boys)
