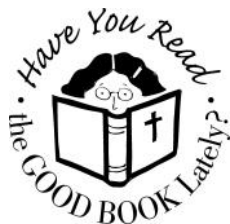

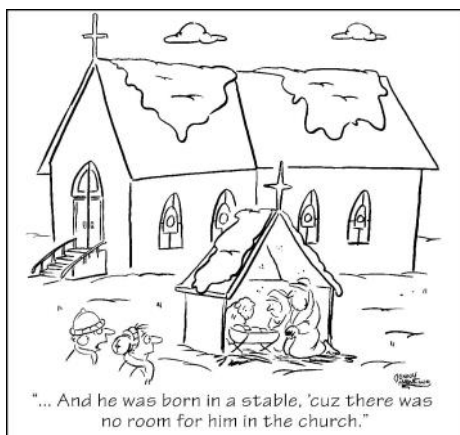
Christmas and Year End Information:
