So what's up with the driveway?

You have no doubt noticed the barrier that has been put up on the driveway beside the building on the east side.

Many people from the community use our parking lot when accessing the hospital. This is a good thing, as it helps those in our community for whom paying the hospital parking fees would be a financial burden. There is also good will in the community for our Church because we have made our parking lot available.

However, our gravel driveway is not adequate to the volume of traffic that has been using it, also there are concerns about the speed at which vehicles drive through from Concession Road to the back parking lot.

In consultation with the North Grenville Fire Prevention Officer, it was determined that the driveway that runs beside the building would not be used as a fire route and could be removed. In the event of a fire, Concession Road and Dr. Gordon Drive would be used by the fire department, not the driveway beside the building. The driveway/fire route was necessary when the Church was built in 1986, as Dr. Gordon Drive did not exist a that time.

The barrier has been erected as a "pilot project" to reduce the amount of through traffic from Concession Road to the parking lot. Vehicles can enter the front horseshoe to drop people off at the front door, but will need to go back out to Concession Road to Dr. Gordon Drive to access the parking lot. People who wish to park in the Church parking lot are requested to access the lot via Dr. Gordon Drive.

It is hoped that by directing the traffic to use Dr. Gordon Drive as much as possible, it will allow us to get ahead, and stay ahead, of the potholes that regularly appear at the front of the horseshoe. The cost of paving the front horseshoe, driveway and back parking lot would be in excess of \$100,000 and is not in the Church budget at this time.

It is also hoped that the blocking off of the driveway will not be an undue inconvenience to the Church family. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact the Church office. Thank you for your patience and understanding.
