Declaration on Euthanasia and Assisted Suicide

We are in the midst of a significant national conversation about the duty of care we owe one another at the end of life, the legalization of euthanasia and the protection of religious freedom and conscience.

Last fall the EFC worked with the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops to develop a Declaration on Euthanasia and Assisted Suicide that was signed by many evangelical denominational leaders as well other faith leaders (Catholic, Orthodox, Jewish and Muslim).
