RING, Update, June 09, 2016

Refugees in North Grenville, RING, is very glad to share the positive news that we now have a potential refugee family - a young Syrian family of four now living outside of Beirut, Lebanon.

Once the government reached the target of assisting 25,000 Syrian refugees, it cut back staffing to Citizen and Immigration in Canada and overseas. This created long delays and uncertainty regarding the government supported system. As a result, RING decided to follow the route to privately sponsor a refugee family.

RING has been working through contacts with One Way Ministries in Ottawa (founder Gerry Organ) for the link to Beirut, Lebanon, and through World Renew (Burlington, Ont.) the Sponsorship Agreement Holder (SAH.) World Renew is the Christian Reform Church's relief and development organization.

Our contact in Beirut identified a family for RING and the sponsorship application paperwork is currently being completed both in Lebanon and here with our SAH.

We have good reason to be optimistic. On our part, we are working to complete the Settlement Plan and Sponsorship Agreement. The goal is to have documents completed by mid-June. However, there will probably be some questions after this. At this point we can't predict if and when the family will be able to travel to Canada.

It's important to note that RING is still on the Blended Visa Office Referral (BVOR) list with World Hope as the SAH, so we are now working both channels towards sponsorship (Government sponsored and private.) This means that the potential for sponsoring a second family is still open. However, as lists of BVORs haven't been forthcoming and there are now many groups hoping to sponsor families this way, we feel that privately sponsoring a refugee family is our best and most expedient route.

We're glad to report that RING has received donations and pledges totalling approximately \$50,000. In addition, furniture and household items (including clothing) valued at another \$15,000 have also been generously donated.

RING will provide another update as soon as we have more definite news. Thank you for all your support, patience and generosity.

Just Imagine... What if we had....

- Visitors from our community sensing a leading to our services were they will find connections and Christ

Pastor Gary, the Strategic Planning Committee and the Official Board with the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, have created a vision for the next steps for our Church. This vision includes a plan for ministry to our youth and children as well as an outreach ministry to our community.

To enable this plan, we would like to hire a youth and children's pastor. However, presently our Church finances are such that in order to support a part time youth and children's pastor for 12 months we are asking our church family to agree with us and commit by faith to give this needed amount of \$10,000

Remember how God provided the almost \$50,000 needed to repair the basement in 2011? Remember how we were given 10 years by the bank to pay off the loan, and we, through God's provision, paid it off in just 3½ years?

There are many other times that God has abundantly blessed this local Church. For example, you may remember the air conditioning project circa 2009 or even more recently God blessing our youth last year in the raising the funds needed to go to Kingdom Bound.

Together as a church family we are walking out the promises of scripture:

Philippians 4:19—And my God will supply all your needs according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus.

Matthew 17:20- Truly I tell you, if you have faith as small as a mustard seed, you can say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it will move. Nothing will be impossible for you."

John 4:35—Lift up your eyes, and look on the fields; for they are white already to harvest.

So as the leadership of the church we are asking you to pray. Pray for His provision for you so that you can by faith give an increase to your present support. We are asking you to commit to by faith a weekly amount commencing July 5th.
