Galatians 1

Vs. 1-5 (vs.4) He gave himself for our sins to rescue us from this present age.

Vs. 6-7 Gospel = good news Greek: euaggelion
yoo-ang-ghel'-ee-on ; a good message, that is, the
gospel: - gospel.

A message void of Jesus is not a good one. Causes
confusion and is a perversion.

Vs. 8-9 Dangers of changing the gospel

Rev 22:18-19 I warn everyone who hears the words of the prophecy of this scroll: If anyone adds anything to them, God will add to that person the plagues described in this scroll. And if anyone takes words away from this scroll of prophecy, God will take away from that person any share in the tree of life and in the Holy City, which are described in this scroll.

Vs. 10 Pleasing people or God? When we don't allow God to satisfy (be enough) we go looking for people to fill the void

Is He enough? **2 Peter 1:3** His divine power has given us everything we need for a godly life through our knowledge of him who called us by his own glory and goodness. **4** Through these he has given us his very great and precious promises, so that through them you may participate in the divine nature, having escaped the corruption in the world caused by evil desires.

When you feel dissatisfied with life do you turn to the good news? What has God rescued you from? Is it still good news to you? Do you struggle with confusion over the gospel? Has someone attempted to pervert it in your life? Have you added other requirements to the salvation message? Do you try to please people more than God? Do you believe He has given you everything you need?

The Father's love is enough. Jesus' payment for your sins is enough. The Holy Spirit in you is enough.
