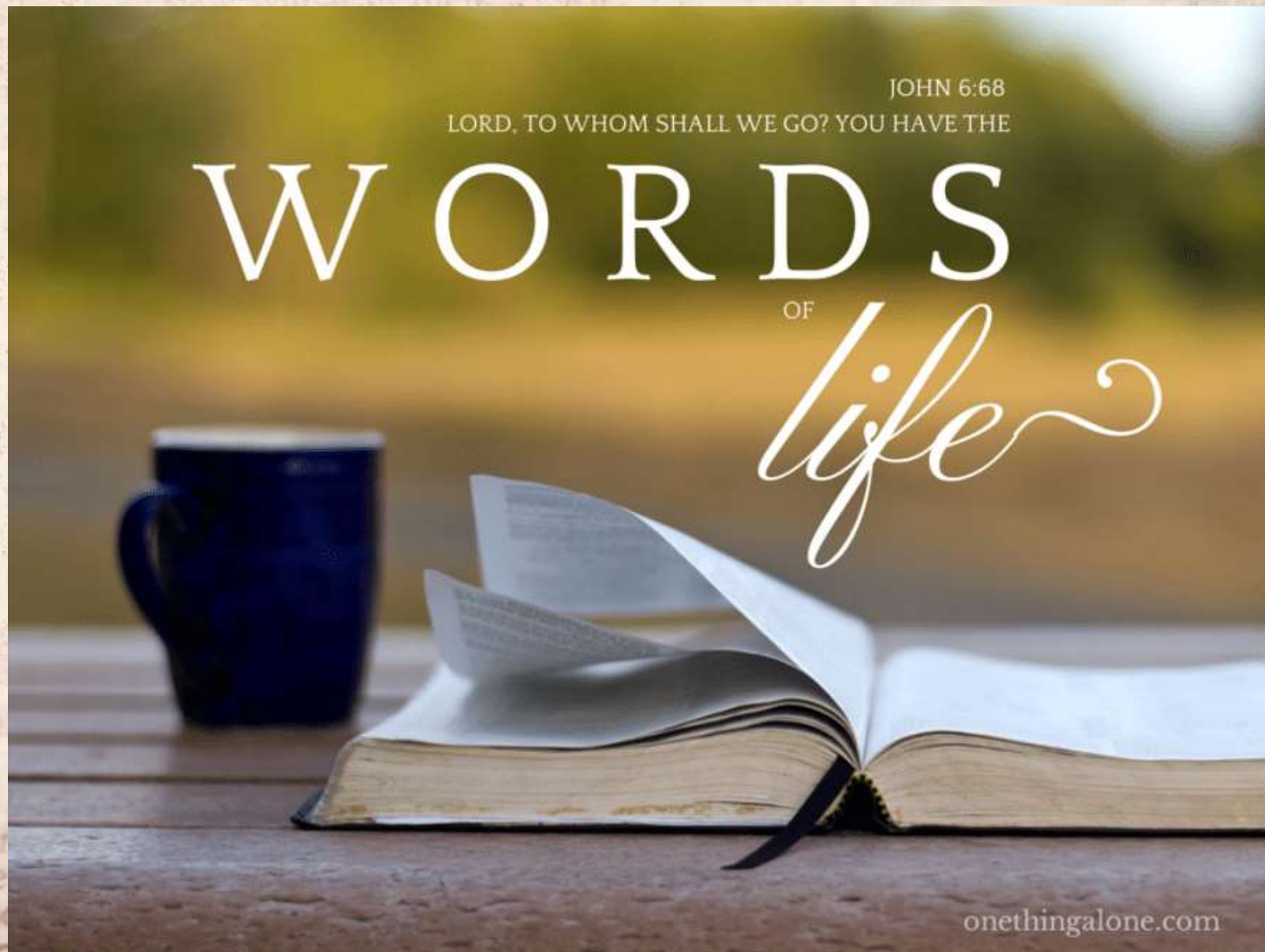
Dead Son, death literal or figurative has impact on the living
