Children's Ministry Directions

We offer supervised nursery care for children aged 0-4 (not in school) and a children's ministry for school aged children from 4-12. Both groups meet on the lower level.

Children are dismissed to their program, midway through the service, after the children's moment. Parents of younger children are invited to accompany their children to their class to sign them in.

The service is audio is broadcast into the foyer and that area is available for kids and little ones who need more room to move. Parents are asked to stay with their kids in the foyer as it is not supervised.

Connect This Week:

Sunday: Sunday Night Prayer 6:30 PM @ Church Come for an informal time of prayer and worship. You can come and go as your schedule allows but we generally wrap up by 8 PM.

Monday: Board Games @ Church. Come and get your (board) game on! Games start at 6 PM, but you can come and go as your schedule allows. The evening wraps up when the games end, usually 9:30 PM or so. Kids are welcome. This event is done in conjunction with Meeples to Go and is an outreach to our community where we welcome people who like to play board games into our Church. Tuesday: Prayer 11AM in the Sanctuary. Join us for a time of prayer. Prayer time is informal and you can come and go as needed, but generally wraps up by 12 PM. Wednesday: Starting at 6:30 PM. There will be classes/activities for kids, Youth and adults at the Church. Everything will wrap up by 8 .

50 Days of Prayer & The 24 Hour Prayer Retreat:

Our Church is devoting ourselves to prayer for the next 50 Days from March 1st to Good Friday (April 19). As a Church would like to fill those days with prayer. We will start with a 24 Hour Prayer Retreat, which will begin at noon on March 1st at the Church.

During the 24 hour prayer retreat there will be stations set up in the sanctuary with resources to help you pray.

There are still a few time slots left, you can sign up in the foyer for an hour time slot.

The time of prayer will end with a concert of prayer at 10:30 AM Saturday.

At the concert of prayer, our plan is to pray through three topics, one each half hour. The topics are praise, unity and vision. The praise section will include music and encourage worship. The focus on unity will be on unity within the body of believers in Kemptville. Lastly, we will seek God's vision for our community and area.
