# **Children's Ministry Directions**

We offer supervised nursery care for children aged 0-4 (not in school) and a children's ministry for school aged children from 4-12. Both groups meet on the lower level.

Children are dismissed to their program, midway through the service, after the children's moment. Parents of younger children are invited to accompany their children to their class to sign them in.

The service is audio is broadcast into the foyer and that area is available for kids and little ones who need more room to move. Parents are asked to stay with their kids in the foyer as it is not supervised.

# Connect This Week:

**Sunday: Listening Prayer @ Church.** Join us starting at 6 PM in the sanctuary for a time of listening prayer. The time is informal, so you can come and go as your schedule allows, but generally wraps up by 7:30 PM.
