Children's Ministry Directions

We offer supervised nursery care for children aged 0-4 (not in school) and a children's ministry for school aged children from 4-12. Both groups meet on the lower level.

Children are dismissed to their program, midway through the service, after the children's moment. Parents of younger children are invited to accompany their children to their class to sign them in.

The service is audio broadcast into the foyer and that area is available for kids and little ones who need more room to move. Parents are asked to stay with their kids in the foyer as it is not supervised.

Connect This Week:

Sunday: Sunday Night Worship and Prayer. Come for an informal time of worship and prayer starting at 6 PM in the Sanctuary.

Monday: Board Games @ Church. Come and get your (board) game on! Games start at 6 PM, but you can come and go as your schedule allows. The evening wraps up when the games end, usually 9:30 PM or so. Kids are welcome. This event is done in conjunction with Meeples to Go and is an outreach to our community where we welcome people who like to play board games into our Church. Tuesday: Prayer 11AM in the Sanctuary. Join us for a time of prayer. Prayer time is informal and you can come and go as needed, but generally wraps up by 12 PM. If you have a prayer request you can fill in a Connect Card and put it in the prayer baskets at the front of the church or call the Church office at 613-258-4815 x 100 or email at office@ngccfm.ca.

Wednesday: Starting at 6:30 PM. There will be classes/activities for kids, Youth and adults at the Church. Everything will wrap up by 8 PM. Finding it hard to get your family fed and to the Church for 6:30? Bring your dinner and come to the Church for anytime between 5:30 and 6:15 PM. There will be tables set up for you to sit and eat at. Everyone is welcome to join in the conversation.

Letter Written at the 22 Hour Prayer Retreat

Dear Children of my community church whom I love;

You have been faithful, when you are in worship it causes rejoicing in heaven. You are large in my eyes. It pleases me that you don't chase after glory for your church, but glory and honour to me: you desire to bring honour to my name. You have kept going in the ebb and flow.

It is my desire that you grow up in faith and in knowledge and understanding of me. Hold a high standard in regards for prayer. There are hidden flames. I desire that they burn bright.

I know that you desire/want to be a presence in your community, but that is a result that comes when you humble yourselves and seek my face. Trust me, trust my plan. (Jeremiah 29:11 - For I know the plans I have for you," declares the LORD, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.) If you grow in this way, I will send you out into the streets to proclaim the Kingdom of God and the Good News of Jesus.

Let me carry you. My joy and peace will be your strength. There will be life (if you follow me). The time is coming when others will look to you for counsel and leadership. *Something new is coming.
