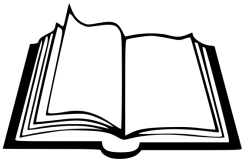

Discussion Questions

1. Today's story is about announcing Jesus as the Rescuer and King, how would you make a big announcement?
2. Why were the disciples and other people shouting and laying down palm branches?
3. Read Zechariah 9:9; Pastor Liz said four things were promised in this passage that happened in the story. What were the four? What else happened in the story that isn't in the verse?
4. What do you think about the promise God made in Zechariah 9:9 hundreds of years before Jesus that came true on Palm Sunday?

Ways to Worship

Here are a few ideas to add to your Palm Sunday celebrations:

- Read Psalm 150: 1-2, 6 a few times out loud with your whole family. Each time through do a different action on the words, "praise." Actions could be jumping, shouting, twirling in a circle, using a noisemaker, saying "Hosanna."
- Have a praise party with upbeat worship music from youtube. The kids have enjoyed "Dance" by the Planetshakers (Fortnite version).

Memory Verse

Our Memory Verse for April is Psalm 23:4b

“I will fear no evil, for you are with me.”

Here are three things you can do to help you memorize this verse:

- 1) Create your own actions or motions or a dance to go with the verse
- 2) Learn to say the verse in American Sign Language. You can do this by googling “ASL” and the keywords “I,” “Fear,” “No,” “Evil” “God” (because that’s who the You is in the verse), “With” and “Me or I.”
- 3) Create a tune to sing using the verse as your lyrics.
